RESEARCH INTERESTS

My Higher Education research agenda addresses educational (in)equity, access, and advocacy, especially transformation regarding minoritized students, staff, and faculty amid intersectional systems of oppression present in society and institutions of higher education. My scholarship centers first generation to college, refugee, newcomer, and ethno-racially minoritized college students (particularly based on class or economic, nationality, citizenship, and migration status). Through critical methodologies of anti-oppression and anti-racism, I foreground these populations' strengths, assets, and knowledge in higher education to highlight institutional responsibilities to undo legacies of racism, white supremacy, and xenophobia.
